CITY OF ROSEBURG PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION MAY 3, 2023

MINUTES

<u>CALL TO ORDER:</u> The meeting of the City of Roseburg Parks and Recreation Commission was called to order at 2:21 p.m. Wednesday, May 3, 2023, in the Third Floor Conference Room at City Hall, Roseburg, Oregon and electronically via Zoom.

<u>ROLL CALL: Present:</u> Chair Patrice Sipos, Commissioners Bob Grubbs, Marsha La Verne, Diana Wales, Tobiah Mogavero, and Ryan Finlay (2:23 p.m.)

Absent: Commissioner Kyle Bailey

Attending Staff: Public Works Director Dawn Easley, Parks and Recreation Program Manager Val Ligon, and Department Technician Chanelle Rogers

Others Present: None

<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES:</u> Commissioner Grubbs moved to approve the minutes of the February 1, 2023 Parks and Recreation Commission meeting. Motion was seconded by Commissioner La Verne and approved with the following vote: Chair Sipos, Commissioners Grubbs, La Verne, Wales and Mogavero voted yes. No one voted no.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

<u>Umpqua Actors Community Theater (UACT) – Improvement Project:</u> Easley informed the reason staff and the commission took a tour of the Betty Long Unruh Theater, just prior to the meeting, is because Umpqua Actors Community Theatre (UACT) would like to expand the theater building that they lease from the City. Easley stated UACT is looking for approval to expand the footprint of the building so they can proceed with fundraising and design. Easley said the City would like to see them be able to expand and recommend allowing them to proceed with a design as step one of the process. Commissioner Wales felt the tour was good and the commission was able to get their questions answered during it.

MOTION: Commissioner Wales moved to forward a recommendation to the City Council to give preliminary approval to UACT's conceptual expansion and renovation. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Grubbs and approved with the following vote: Chair Sipos, Commissioners Grubbs, La Verne, Wales, Finlay, and Mogavero voted yes. No one voted no.

Park Rules Update: Easley informed staff recognized it would be a good time to update the Parks Rules and Regulations to align with the proposed amendment to the Roseburg Municipal Code (RMC) in regards to Prohibited Camping. Easley stated the park rules as they are now might conflict with the proposed amendment to RMC regarding individuals experiencing homelessness. Staff would like to amend the Park Rules and Regulation to align with the proposed amendment to RMC 7.02.100 regulating time, place, and manner. Commissioner Grubbs inquired if the boundaries of the parks are defined well enough that someone would know if they were in or out of a park. Easley feels they are pretty well defined. Commissioner Grubbs questioned if all approved organized events should be listed or does the wording "such as" cover everything. Commissioner Wales felt the City Attorney maybe to choose to leave it with "such as" so if in the future other approved events would be allowed and not a specific list.

Commissioner Grubbs replied that there is already somewhat of a specific list. Ligon stated that particular rule is not excluding and organized event those are just events that have been regular events in the parks for many years. Commissioner Grubbs also asked about the rule pertaining to Firs Responders and vehicles. Easley replied that she worked closely with the City Attorney and Police Chief on the wording and the rules now reference Oregon Revised Statute 801.590 in reference to the definition of a vehicle. This was to be able to allow First Responder or maintenance vehicles but not any other vehicles. Commissioner Wales questioned if the rules should reference the Municipal Code section rather than the Ordinance. Easley said she would check on that but agreed that it probably should.

MOTION: Commissioner Grubbs moved to approve the revised Parks Rules and Regulations and to recommend to City Council the adoption of a resolution repealing and replacing the City of Roseburg Park Rules and Regulations. Motion was seconded by Commissioner La Verne and approved with the following vote: Chair Sipos, Commissioners Grubbs, La Verne, Wales, Finlay, and Mogavero voted yes. No one voted no.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION: None

<u>INFORMATIONAL:</u> Easley informed the Sunshine Trail project went to the County Commissioners for an appeal and the Commissioners repealed the County Planning Conditional Use Permit for the project. Staff is now looking at appealing to LUBA.

BUSINESS FROM THE COMMISSION: Commissioner Wales informed the Swifts are back but not sure where they are at for sure. There will not be a Spring Swift watch but they will be doing one in the fall.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 2:40 p.m.


