In-N-Out Burger Reading Program Returns Kris Wiley Roseburg Public Library

The In-N-Out Burger reading program is back at Roseburg Public Library.

Local youth ages 4 through 12 are invited to read books for burgers now through April 12. A Roseburg Public Library card is not required.

The reading log is available to download on the library's website at <a href="www.roseburgpubliclibrary.org">www.roseburgpubliclibrary.org</a>. Logs also are available at the library's front desk. Alternately, school groups may email staff at <a href="library@roseburgor.gov">library@roseburgor.gov</a>, and we will work through the details with a designated adult.

The log allows youth to track their reading in one of two ways. They may count the number of books or minutes they read (parents or caregivers may read to children). When they read five books or five hours, they are eligible for a gift card for a free hamburger or cheeseburger at In-N-Out.

Youth may continue to read and receive up to three burgers for their efforts.

Each time a milestone is reached, stop by the library's front desk. We distribute the gift cards, track the number of children participating and log the number of books or minutes read.
