I could not ask for better friends than the Friends of the Roseburg Public Library.

Over the past year, they have donated \$33,000 to library projects and programs, enabling us to provide even more for the community.

Their most recent contribution funded an upgrade of the sound system in the Ford Room. There now are two handheld and two lapel microphones that are wired into large, wall-mounted speakers. Early feedback from users has been positive.

The Friends always have been a major sponsor of the Summer Reading Program, and this year is no different. Their funds are used to provide the grand prizes – this year, four yearlong family passes to the YMCA of Douglas County – along with smaller prizes, supplies for crafts and special performers.

The group raises funds through several book sale avenues.

Currently, the Friends Book Store inside the library offers remains from the last large book sale. Hardcover books are 50 cents each; paperbacks and children's books are 25 cents each.

Large sales occur quarterly in March, June, September and December. The next large sale is scheduled for Sept. 4 through 6 and will feature library withdrawals and well-loved material.

Finally, a dedicated crew works year-round managing the Friends' Amazon bookstore, which sells and ships material across the country. These books have higher price points than most of what is sold at the library.

The Friends always accept donations of books, DVDs and audiobooks on CD in good condition. Drop off your items at the library's front desk during open hours. A donation receipt is provided upon request.
