You are hereby notified of the following changes, deletions, additions, corrections and clarifications to the plans, specifications and other documents comprising the Contract Documents for the City of Roseburg, 2022 ADA Ramp Replacement project.

Clarifications

Question: How deep are the curb inlets?

Response: On sheets C.11, C.12 and C.15, the curb inlets shall be assumed 4.0' in depth to the invert out plus the 12" sump to the bottom of the structure. Awarded contractor to field verify dimensions prior to shop drawing submittal and ordering of curb inlets.

- 2. Question: Can 5.0 feet truncated domes be utilized in pathways that exceed 5.0 feet?
 - Response: The maximum spacing between the domes and edge is 2". Domes will need to be cut to meet ADA specifications.
- 3. Question: Do curbs and sidewalks need to be poured monolithically?

Response: Curbs and sidewalks do not need to be poured monolithically. However, if they are poured separately, dowels must be installed.
